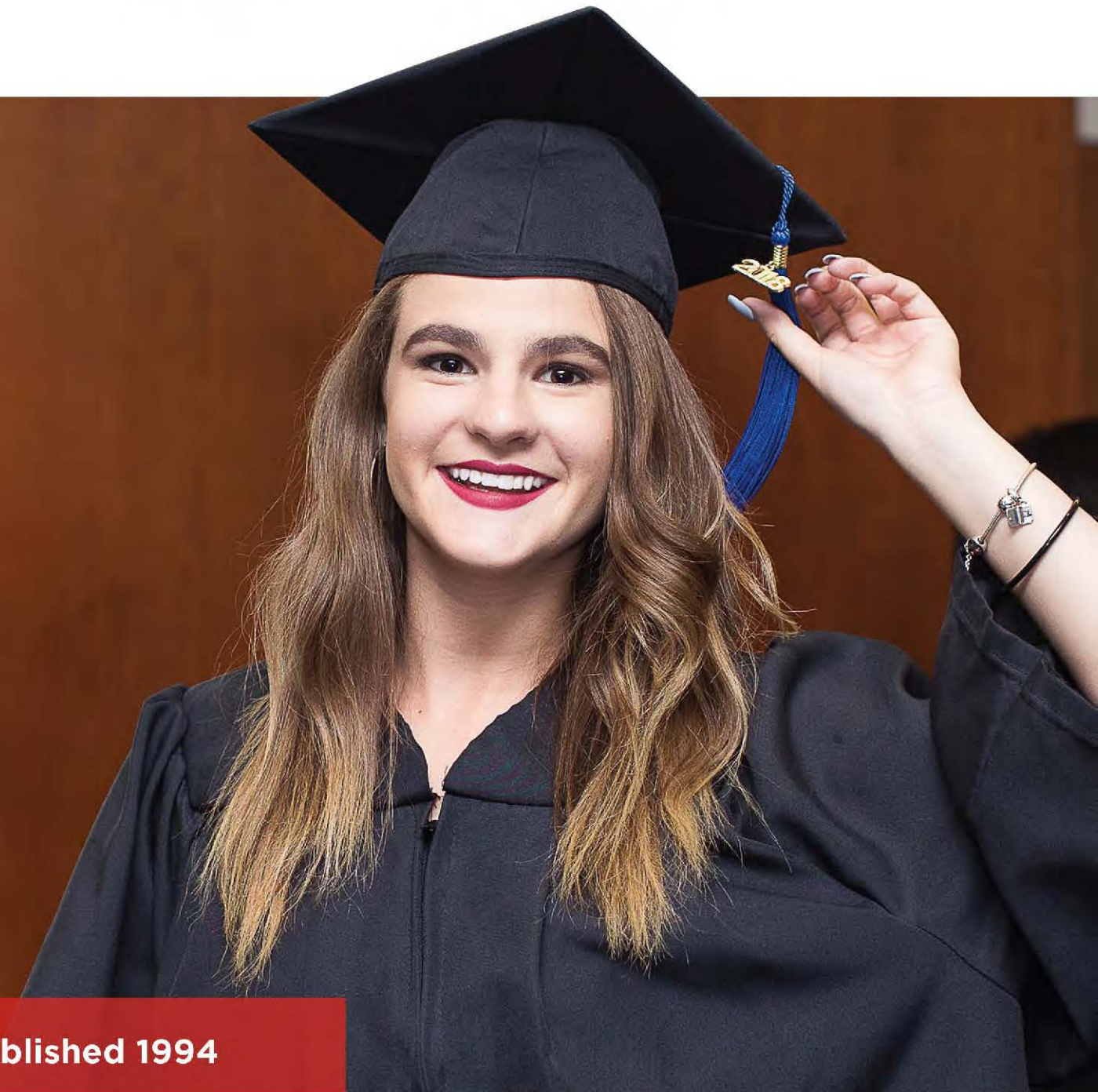

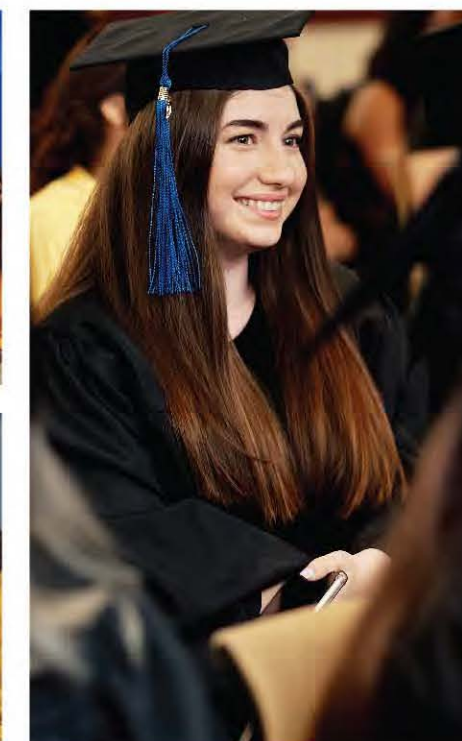


## Programs

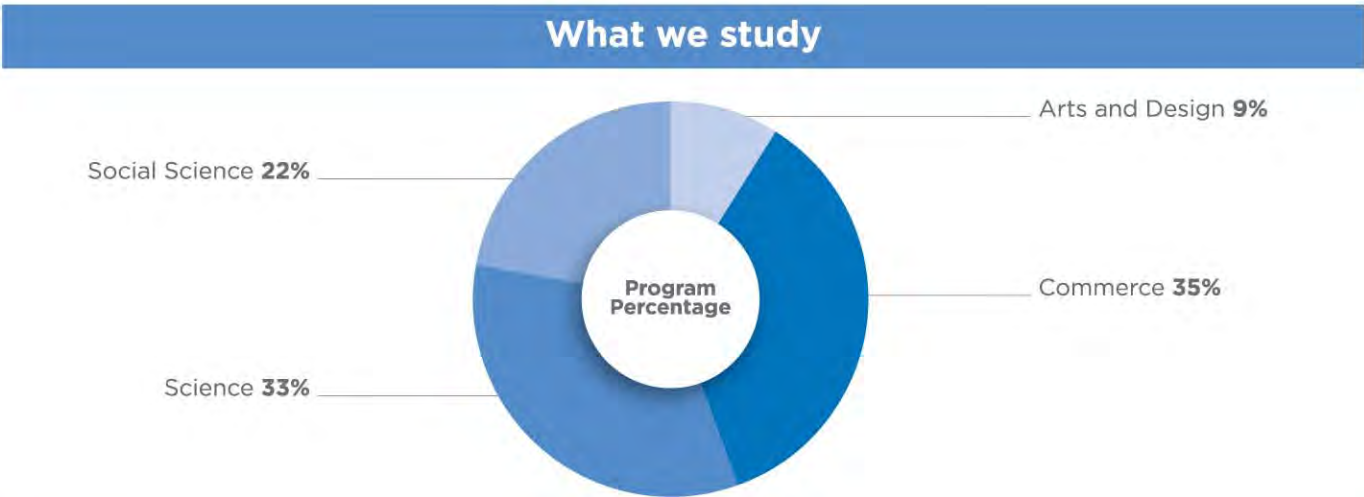
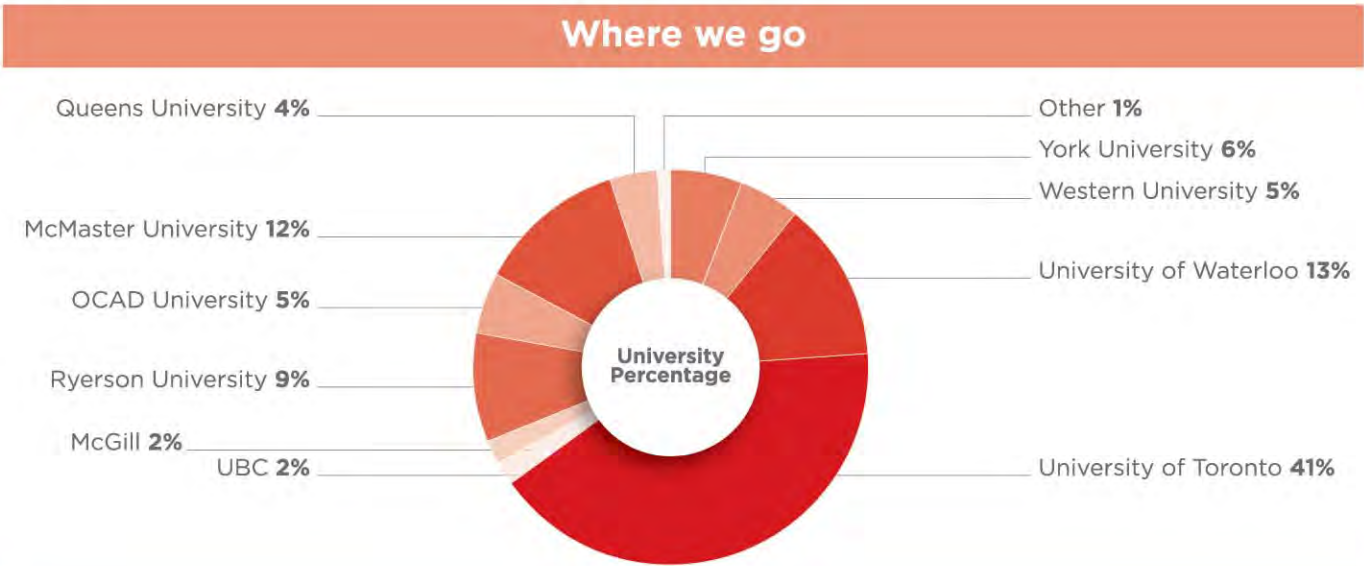
- Grade 9 -11

- Students can earn up to 12 credits in one academic school year





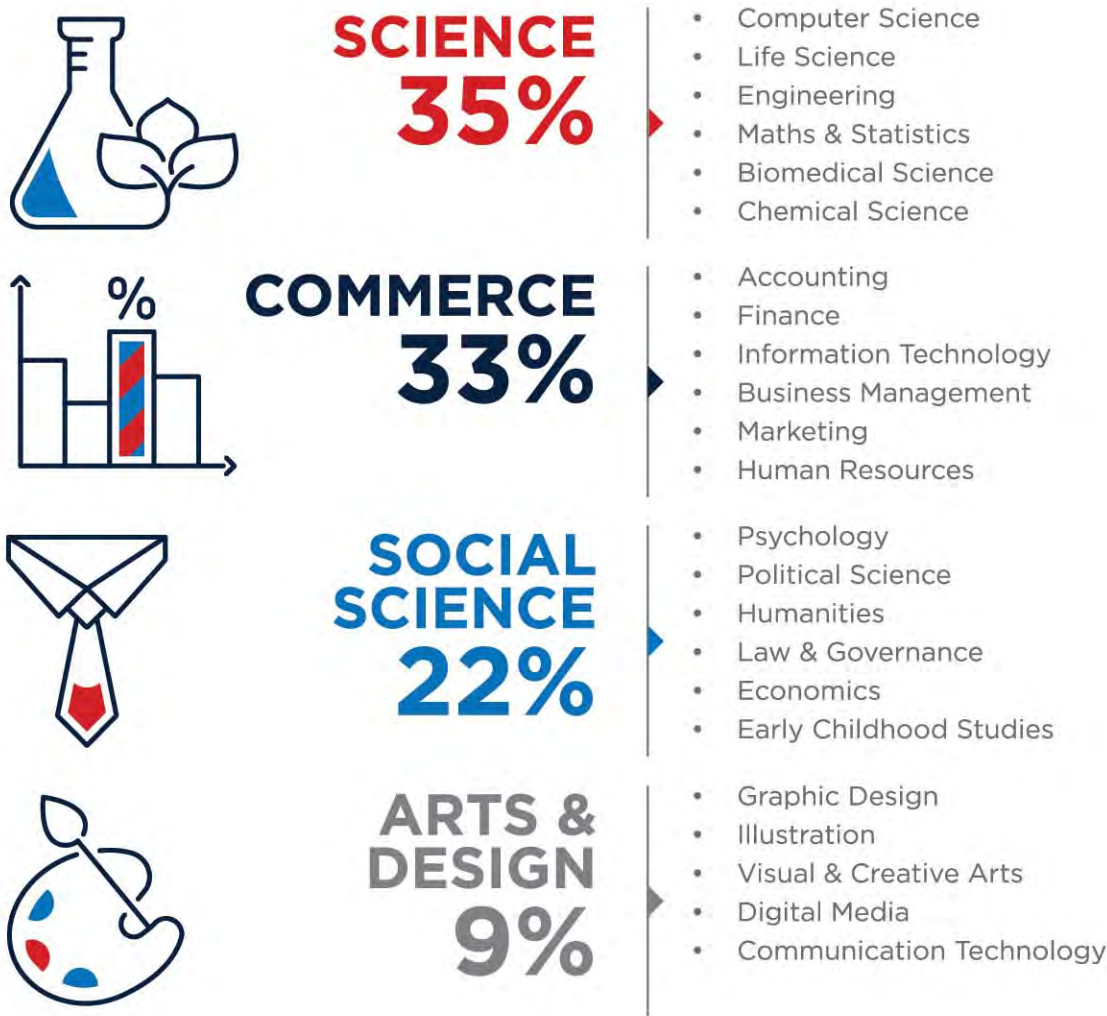
